Guidelines

We are inviting all Broward County School Students to use their creativity, video production, and storytelling skills to write and produce a video that celebrates your club, organization, class, or group accomplishments.

GOAL

Your goal is to help others see the amazing things you do as a group to improve the lives of students and contribute to your school, community and the world!

Remember to motivate viewers to get involved! Invite them to join a group or start one of their own.

PRODUCTION TIPS

VIDEO: Videos must be 30 or 60 seconds long. Keep your storyline simple and to the point. Every shot should move your story forward.

SOUND: If your talent is speaking on camera, use an external microphone wired into your camera. If you are relying on your camera microphone, shoot as close to your subject as possible. If you are using voice over, make sure the talent speaks into the microphone. Your message should be clear and appropriate for all age groups.

MUSIC: Use original or "Public Domain" music only. No copyrighted songs allowed.
