Why Prevention?

Research supports the link between prevention and academic success. Schools play a critical role in delivering prevention programs while promoting academic excellence. DPI ensures BCPS achieves this by utilizing the Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS.)

MTSS uses a data driven tiered approach to instruction delivery that includes interventions of increasingly higher intensity, based on each student's needs – academic, behavioral, social and emotional. Resources and interventions for the other strands of prevention (diversity, health & wellness, instructional strategies, substance abuse and violence prevention) are provided within the MTSS tiered model at the universal (Tier 1), targeted group (Tier 2), and intensive (Tier 3) levels.
