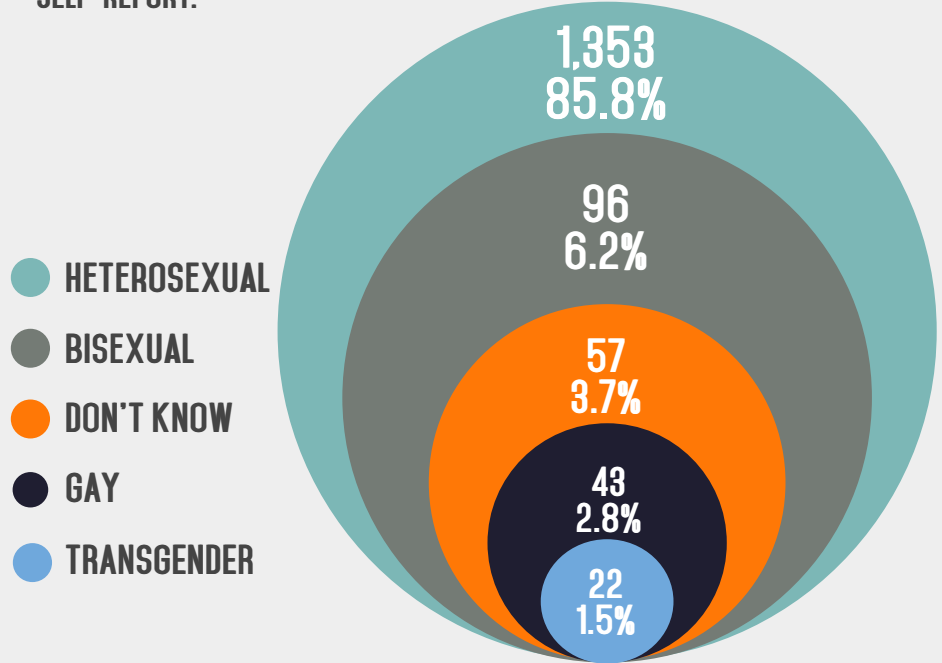

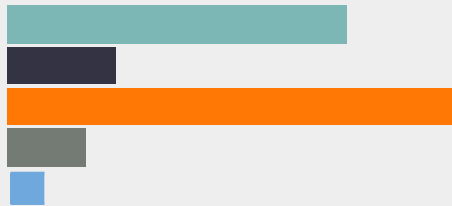


IDENTITY REPORT

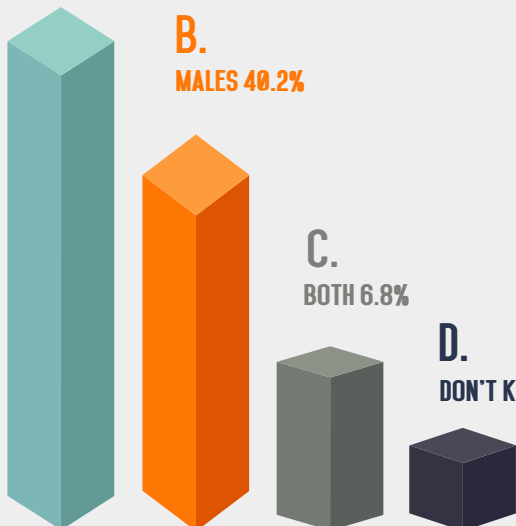
