

# Anti-Bullying Policy 5.9 & Dating Violence Policy 5010

## Training Modules F.A.Q.

**2. Who is required to complete the training modules?**

### **Anti-Bullying (Grades K-12):**

- All staff are required to complete the Anti-Bullying training modules.
- All students K-12 are required to complete the Anti-Bullying training modules. In the Anti-Bullying Toolkit you will find the following training modules: K-2, 3-5, Middle-High School, and staff.
- The Principal's designated administrator who serves as the school's Investigative Designee will complete the annual Brainshark training.
- The parent training module resource will be made available to families through multiple means and communication tools.

### **Dating Violence or Abuse (Grades 6-12):**

- All middle and high school staff are required to complete the Dating Violence training module.
- All middle and high school students are required to complete the Dating Violence training module.
- The Principal's designated administrator who serves as the school's Investigative Designee will complete the annual Brainshark training.
- The parent training module resource will be made available to families through multiple means and communication tools.

**3. For staff training, should they all type in their information?** Yes, each staff member must submit their first and last name, personnel number, and location number. This is how compliance will be tracked and this information will be reflected on the Certificate of Completion you will need to print and keep for your records. **To receive a completion certificate you must view the entire presentation, listen to all the audio, and score at least 75% on the questions.**

**4. What happens in the event a person gets a score lower than 75%?** They will have to sign in again and re-take the test.
